

## Assembly Instructions:



Parts included

1. Position cushion onto the bumper and fasten into the two predrilled center holes using the  $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{3}{4}$ " hi-lo screws and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " washers. The screws may be installed with a screwdriver or a cordless drill. **Caution: Do not over tighten or thread in too quickly as this will strip the threads. Be especially careful if using a cordless drill.** 



2. Hold the cushion in place and drill out the remaining holes with a  $5/32^{\circ}$  drill bit. A  $3/16^{\circ}$  bit may be used but it will not provide as much holding power. Install the remaining  $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  hi-lo screws into the bumper. Do not over tighten as this will strip the threads and is not covered under warranty.



3. Slide bumper into the H-channel on the dock. Tipping it at an angle and working it back and forth will allow it to slide in easier. Silicone spray and a mallet may be used if necessary. Slide it down the H-channel until the tab and the attachment hole line up with a hole in the decking.



4. Insert the  $3/8 \times 5$ " bolt and washer into the attachment hole and tighten securely.
